Apple Day Ideas



Apple Day is on 21st October every year, an annual celebration of apples, orchards and local distinctiveness. Initiated by Common Ground in 1990, it has since been celebrated each year by people organising hundreds of local events.

Seasonal events

- Wassailing: The Orchard-Visiting wassail refers to the practice of singing to trees in apple orchards in cider-producing regions of England to promote a good harvest for the coming year.
- Tree Dressing: Tree Dressing Day aims to encourage the
 celebration of trees in city and country anywhere in the public
 domain. It highlights our responsibility for looking after trees and
 reminds us of their enormous cultural and environmental
 importance. Tree dressing is based on many old customs from
 around the world and at different times of the year. Groups and
 individuals dress their trees all over the country. Always the first
 full weekend in December.

Create your own celebration of the trees in your school grounds.
 This cross-cultural community expression for everyday nature could include storytelling, dance, music, hanging ribbons, shapes, shining lights, anything which draws attention to the trees we often take for granted.

Activity ideas

- Board games Apple solitaire, apple tree man and orchard scrumpers, red apple/green apple (5x5 board red and green apples for a pattern opposite each other 5 on back row, then 4, then 3 to 1 leaving a square spare in the middle. The idea is to swap sides by moving in any direction except backwards or jumping over one another. The first to the other side in the original formation wins.)
- Apple Recipes design and sell your own recipe cards or book
