

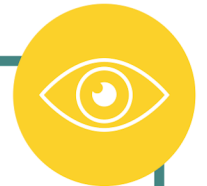

Try using adjectives and similes when describing the beans.



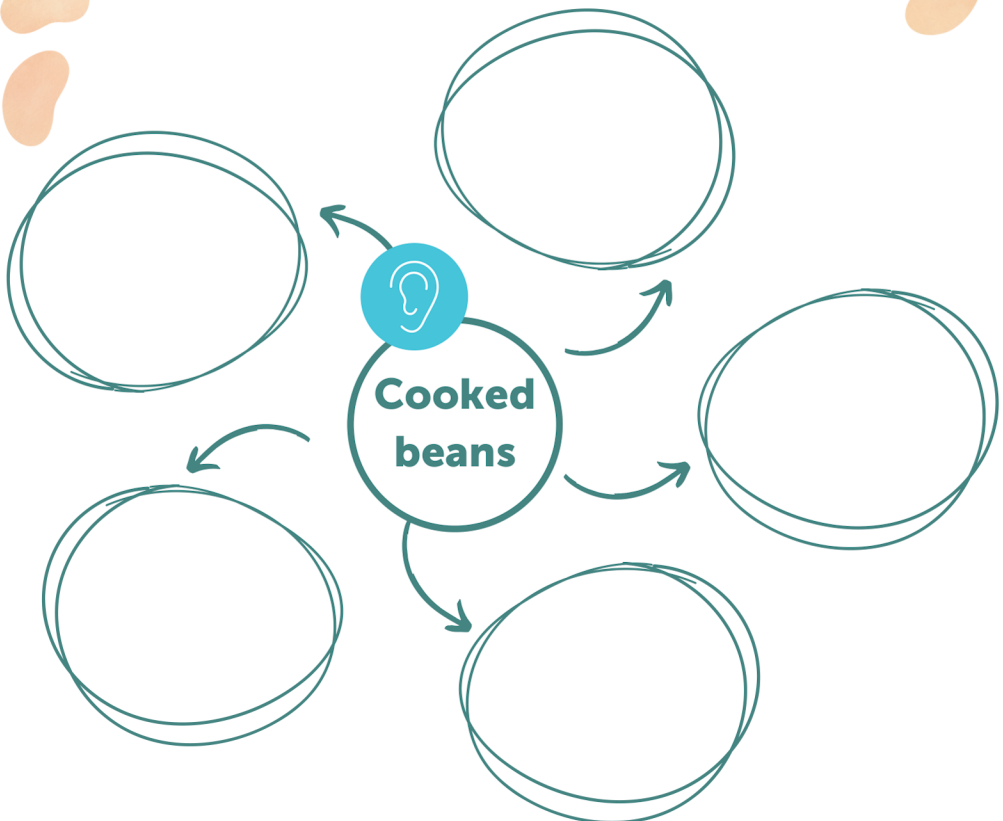
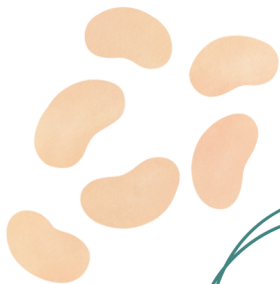
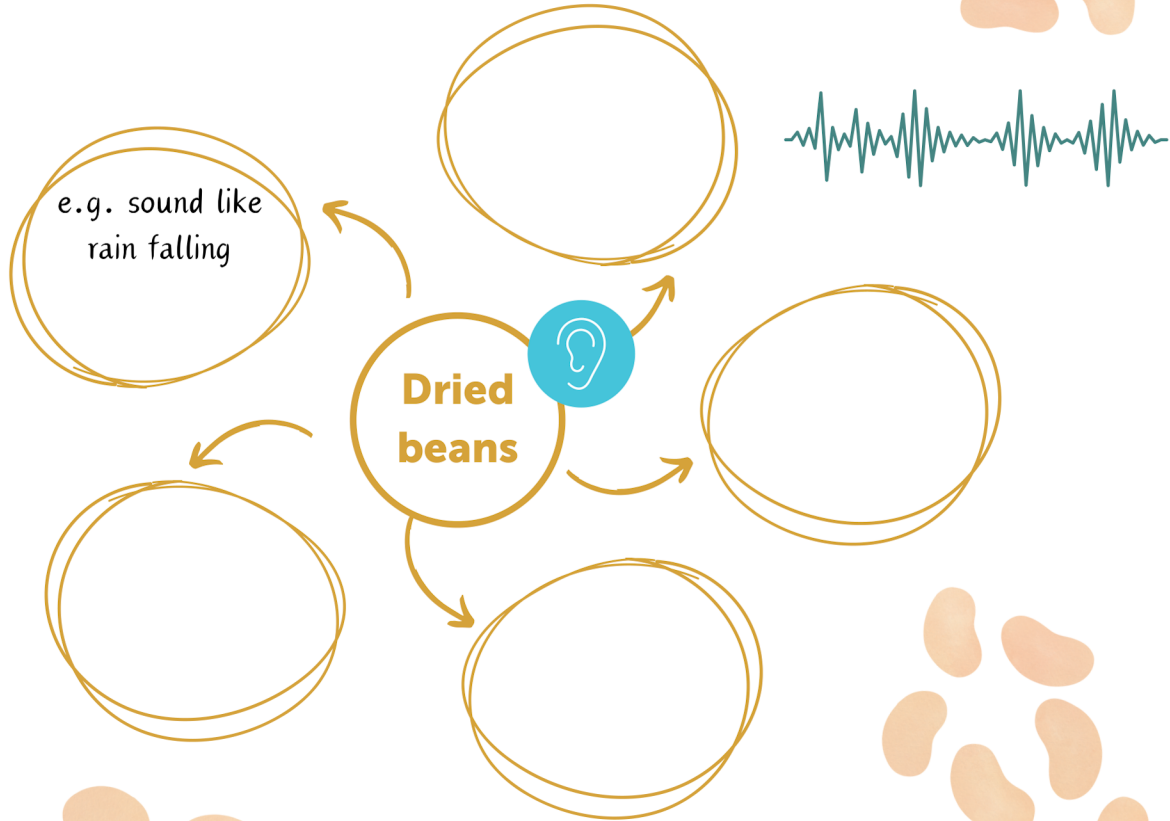
Task 1: SIGHT

Task 2: SOUND

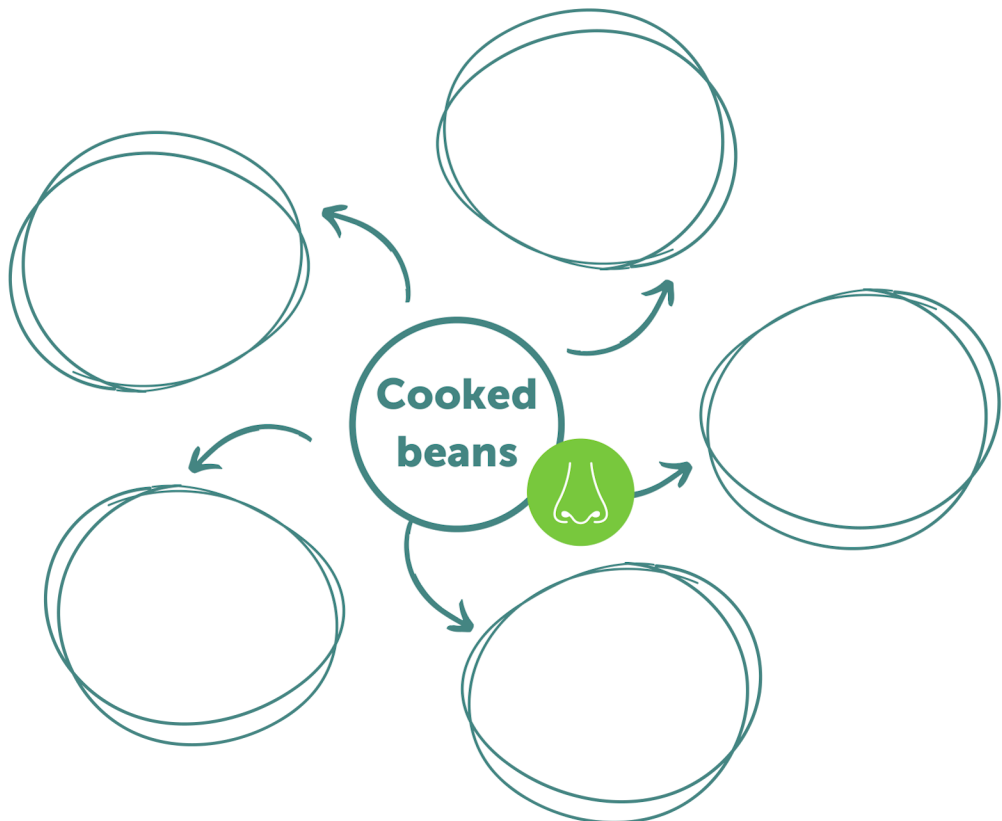
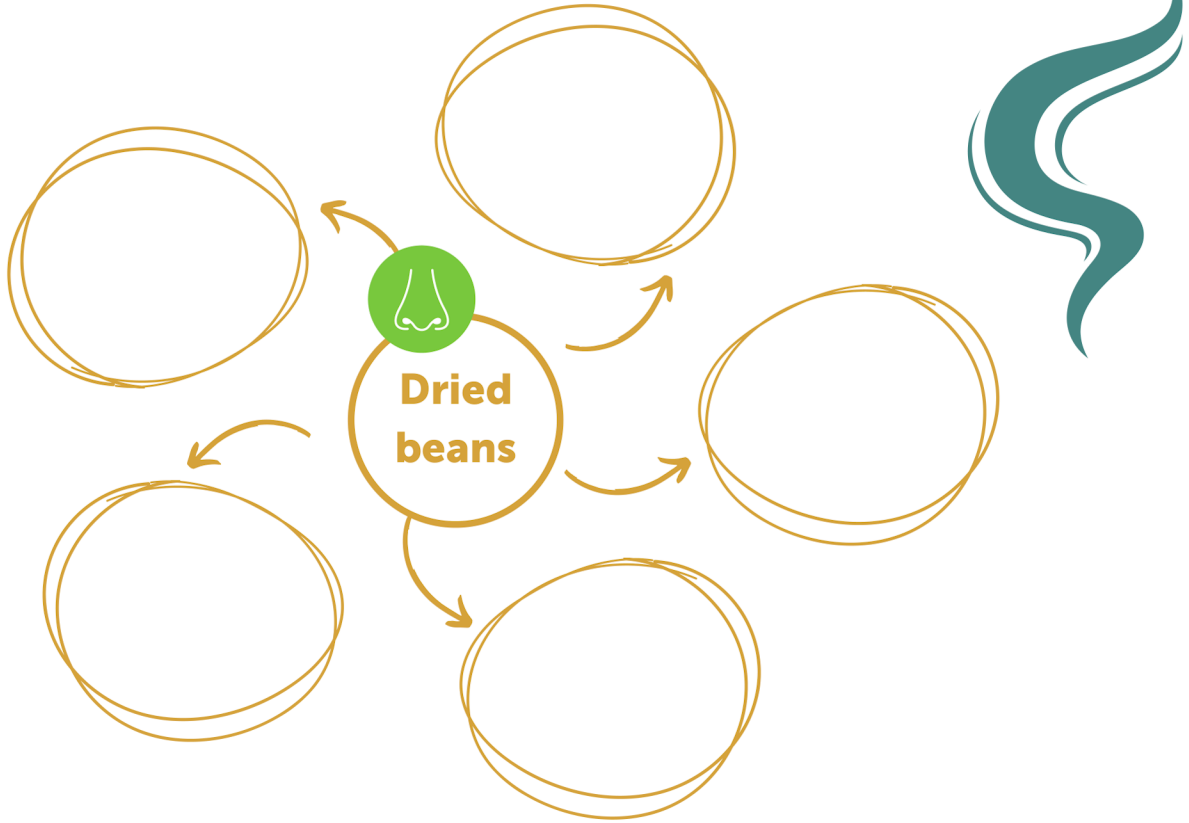
1. Shake the beans in their containers.

Task 3: SMELL

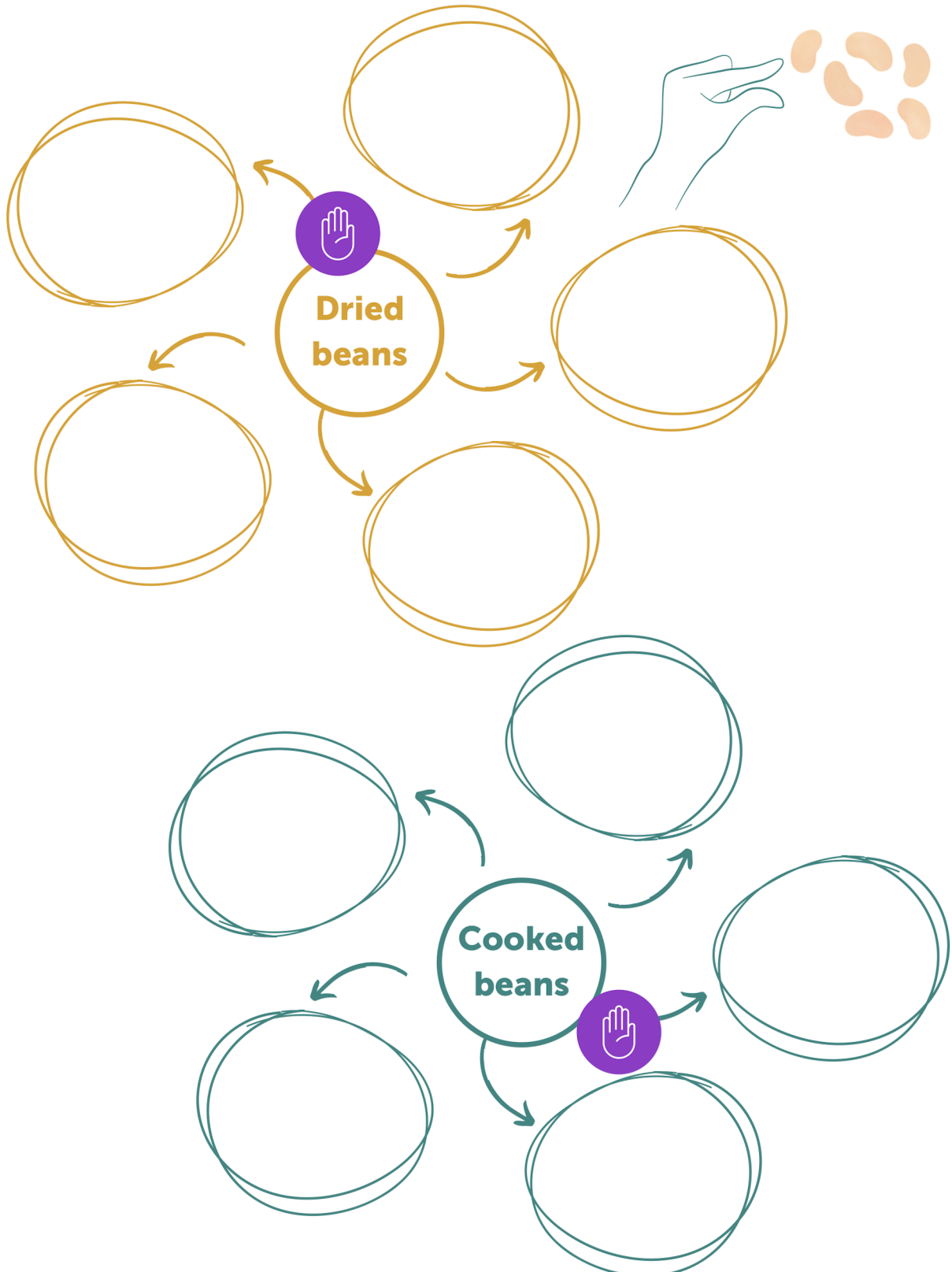
1. Smell each container of beans.
