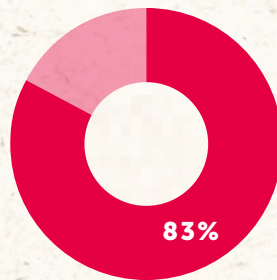

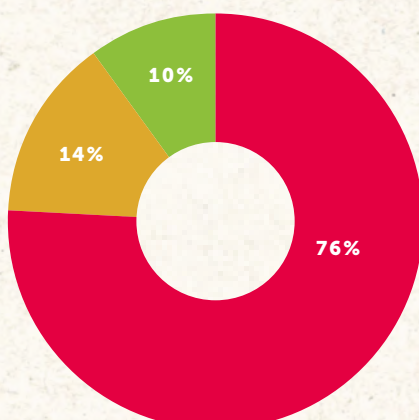

INDEX OF MULTIPLE DEPRIVATION DATA SHOWS THAT 76% OF ENROLLED SCHOOL AND NURSERY SETTINGS IN WALSALL FALL WITHIN THE 1-30% MOST DEPRIVED DECILES.
